## **Prime Time Communications to acquire Utah's Mstar**

**Prime Time Communications** LLC said Tuesday it plans to acquire Utah-based Internet service provider **Mstar**. Terms of the proposed deal were not announced.

Englewood-based Prime Time Communications is a provider of digital Internet, video and phone service over a fiber-optic system, with about 5,500 customers in Colorado, Utah, Nevada, Mississippi and Kansas.

It says it plans to complete the Mstar transaction in March.

In a statement Tuesday, Prime Time said it will bring Mstar's subscribers enhanced voice and video services.

Mstar currently provides service over the Utah Telecommunication Open Infrastructure Agency, or UTOPIA, a collaboration of Utah cities that operates a fiber-optic network.
